

UC is test-free. UCSB will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions or scholarship decisions.



A-G Courses

Complete UC-approved A-G courses with a posted grade of "C" or better. Refer to hs-articulation.ucop.edu/quide.

- A. History/social science: 2 yrs
- B. English: 4 yrs
- C. Mathematics: 3 yrs (4 recommended)
- D. Science: 2 yrs (3 recommended)



Grade Point Average (GPA)

Earn a weighted 3.0 minimum GPA (3.4 for nonresidents) in A-G courses.

- E. Language other than English: 2 yrs (3 recommended)
- F. Visual/performing arts: 1 yr
- G. College preparatory elective: 1 yr beyond the minimum A-F courses required

UCSB considers 13 holistic review factors showcasing achievements in the context of opportunities and/or challenges a student has experienced.

Seven-Course Pattern

Complete the seven-course pattern with a "C" or better:

- A. 2 courses in English composition (UC-E)
- B. 1 course in mathematics beyond intermediate algebra, like precalculus or statistics (UC-M)
- C. 4 courses from at least two of the following areas:
 - Arts and humanities (UC-H)
 - Behavioral and social sciences (UC-B)
 - Biological and physical sciences (UC-S)

TAG guarantees admission to CA community college students who meet specific requirements. admissions.ucsb.edu/tag

Complete 60 semester/90 quarter units of UCtransferable credit.




